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ABOUT THE COURSE

This course gives an in-depth understanding of the development of the child from 3 to 6 years of age and how best to support the child's developmental needs during this period.

This course enables a thorough study of the educational theory and practice of the Montessori approach and prepares the trainee to run a 3-6 Montessori classroom / start a pre-school.

COURSE FORMAT

Modular & Blended (Onsite and Online)

This AMI 3-6 Diploma offers a blended study option, with 3 in-person modules in Kolkata, India, spread out across one winter, one summer and a fall and 2 online modules in-between.

To support those already working as educators:

The two in-person modules during winter and fall will be conducted post lunch.

The two online modules will be conducted after school hours. The one summer in-person module will have full-day sessions.

An additional 7 weeks of School observation and practice teaching will need to be completed in between the modules.

- Observation in a 3-6 Montessori environment
- Teaching Practice in 3-6 Montessori environment
- 90% attendance
- Successful completion of written and oral examinations
